- You need to be an approved Volunteer to assist. Volunteers will sign in at the office, wear a vest and be the only other adults in the change rooms. You are welcome to come along and watch (although we're sure you've already had plenty of time sweating it out at swimming lessons) and ask that you respect our process.
- Students are grouped by BASC staff and they are not to be approached by parents/carers. If you have an issue, please speak to the school teacher in charge of the Prep class at the pool.
- Preps need goggles, a swim cap and to wear their bathers to school under their sports uniform, which can be worn for the duration of the swimming program.
- Please pack some extra food, as they get hungry and we are going across breaks: some eating early or late.
- No lunch orders during this program please as we are eating at different times.



- We have also been covering the Respectful Relationships curriculum area of Keeping My Body Safe, which fits well with having to get changed at the pool. It is also a good time for you to have the conversation at home.
