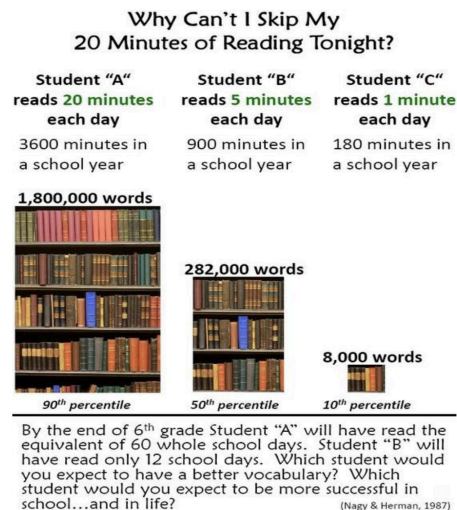


Using External Doors
