Mission Fete

This Friday is our Mission Fete, the favourite day of our school year for many students. We also use part of the money raised to support local community groups.

Students have been learning more about this in their Inquiry/Religion unit called "Special and Worthy" this term.

We have been learning about money and the value of each coin in Maths and it would be good to practise some 'buying' at home too. This helps them to be more independent at the Fete and not require adult support. Older students are also great at helping them out.

You are very welcome to attend the Fete but it's also good to give them their independence and go off with friends, if they are keen to do so. We will take them around the school and talk about where everything is before the Fete starts.
