Writing

You have probably noticed from remote learning that we are working on the genre of poetry for writing. We have been exploring different types of poems and looking at rhyme.

Mathematics

During remote learning we had a focus on fractions including finding fractions of an object or group of objects. We are now moving onto the concept of time where we will be working on telling the time to the hour and half hour or beyond depending on your child's stage of learning, sequencing events, describing how long things take and learning the days, months and year.





Outdoor Learning

Just a reminder to bring along raincoats, gum boots and beanies each day so the students are prepared for any weather as we continue to promote outdoor learning.

<u>Swimming</u>

Year 1 students will participate in a 9 day swimming lesson program at the Bellarine Aquatic and Sports Centre between Monday 9 August and Friday 20 August. There will be no swimming on Wednesday 11 August.

Students will need to bring goggles (already fitted), a swimming cap, towel and a change of underwear in a bag each day. Students are to wear their sports uniform every day during the swimming program, and to wear their bathers under their sports uniform. *Please ensure all items are clearly labelled.*

The sessions will be as follows:

The students will be walking to the pool. Each class will be leaving school 15 minutes before their session commences. Parents who are registered volunteers with Our Lady Star of the Sea School, and who hold a current Working with Children Check are required to help walk the students over to the pool and with supervision in the change rooms. Please let your child's class teacher know if and when you can help.

Depending on COVID restrictions, parents are welcome to come and watch the sessions.
